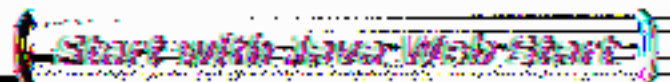


Jalview

WebStart - automatically checks that you are using the most up to date version!
If you know that you have already installed it on your system, use WebStart



Don't have Java version 1.4 or later, first install Java on your machine from from the Java [load site](#) - then click on the [Install](#) link above.

If your browser hasn't been set up to run Java WebStart (N.I.T files), the [Start](#) link above will make a file called `javaws.jar` or `javaws.exe` with the signature to go over to download it (instead of automatically downloading it somewhere, or presenting it to you as text). If a dialog box with "Open using application..." on it, use the `javaws` application to run your file (and the box marked "Don't ask me again"):

```
<path to java runtime> installation->bin\javaws
<path to jdk installation> ->jre\bin\javaws
javaws.exe
```

If you think that your browser should really be working with Java properly, you can test it at [java.com](#). If things really are not working, use the [InstallAnywhere](#) version of Jalview [listed below](#).
